If you are affected by the road closures listed and need to leave your home using a vehicle, please do so before 08:00am or move your vehicle to a location outside of the road closures. There will be no traffic movement permitted during the time of the event.

### Diversions will be fully signposted and will operate via the following routes:

- Ernesettle Route: Uxbridge Drive – Biggin Hill – Devon Expressway or Crownhill Road
- St Budeaux Route: Lower Victoria Road, St Budeaux Square, Fletemoor Road, Weston Mill Road & Kings Tamerton Road

**We employ a Traffic Management Company** to manage all closures and reopen roads as soon as it is safe to do so. Their operational window is 06:30 – 11:30, but roads will be reopened progressively as athletes pass through.

**A dynamic reopening of roads will begin from 09:30**, or earlier if participants have cleared that section of the route. All roads are expected to be fully reopened by midday.

**Emergency Services are fully aware of the event** and its road closures, and we will cooperate with them in case of any accidents or incidents.
